Overview

The purpose of this deliverable is a series of events that are offered to groups of teachers, science museum staff and researchers (selected from the university staff and schools) of the participating organizations. The training includes user's workshops in order for the trainees to become skilled with the SCeTGo system, the miniatures and all other relevant tools (e.g. webcam, markers)

Execution

In 2010 there were 3 specific events using the 5 miniatures and the draft technical and user's manuals (D3.1 and D3.3). This has ensured that there are sufficient teachers, science museum staff and researchers of the participating organizations skilled with the the SCeTGo system, the miniatures and all other relevant tools (e.g. webcam, markers).

a) Cluj Napoca

In Romania(CCD Cluj) there were 35 physics teachers from the Cluj county in the training held in 2nd and 3rd November

b) Helsinki

A workshop was held in Heureka (25th and 26th November). There were 124 students and 73 questionnaire was retrieved. Students were from University of Helsinki, department of teacher education.

c) Athens

Prior to, and during the project meeting December 1, 2 and 3. Project team members from CER, Linnaeus University (formally Vaxjo U), ICCS, University of Barcelona and Elenigermaniki Agogi (12 persons) were given training in use of the miniatures and other relevant tools.

Future Execution

As the suitcase of miniatures travels to partners as part of the validation activity further training will be given in those locations where the suitcase has not visited.
